The combination of that which in the example sentences is fine. The that is a pronoun referring back to a noun phrase and the which is the relative pronoun used for non-animate antecedents. If we expand the shortest of the OP's example sentences to replace the pronoun that with its noun referent, we get: A very small part of acting is acting which takes place on the stage!

Which is which (or that)? It's essential (and non-essential) to know "That" restricts the reader's thought, directing attention to a specific bit of information to complete a message's meaning. "Which" is non-restrictive and introduces subsidiary rather than essential information to the meaning of the sentence.
